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The Care Leaver Progression Partnership

The Care Leaver Progression Partnership (CLPP) is a collective of organisations in Kent and Medway, joined in a commitment to improving the post-16 education and training experience for local children in care and care leavers. Our members are as follows:



The CLPP is steered through a strategy group made up of representatives from each partner organisation, and who meet four times per year.

What do we do?

The CLPP exists for the benefit of its members in serving the young people that they work with in Kent and Medway. We are a collective endeavour to better understand and remove the barriers to post-16 education and training for local children in care and care leavers.

All members commit to the partnership financially, and work to agreed Terms of Reference and objectives that are reviewed annually. All members sign an agreement which runs for three years.

The CLPP is governed by a steering group comprising of a representative from each member institution, and chaired by Canterbury College.

What are our mission, vision and core values?

Mission

To share best practice and work towards a consistent approach to tracking, data and resource for Looked After Children and Young Care Leavers in, and prospective to, post-compulsory education and training in Kent and Medway.

Vision

Partners of the CLPP work in collaboration to enhance the post-compulsory education and training experience for all local Looked After Children and Young Care Leavers, irrespective of their local authority corporate parent, disability, NEET or asylum status.

Core Values

- Collaboration through mutual respect
- Creating an environment for academic success across the whole of Kent and Medway
- Inspiring and empowering Looked After Children and Young Care Leavers to achieve their academic potential
- Keeping Looked After Children and Young Care Leavers at the heart of everything we do
- Owning our individual and corporate responsibility

How do we do it?

- The sharing of best practice amongst its members
- The setting up and running of sub groups and working groups, such as the Designated Member of Staff (DMS) group
- The collection and sharing of data from all member institutions, and the use of this data to inform future objectives
- An annual conference which focuses on issues decided by the partnership, and which is also open to non CLPP members
- Lobbying of local and central Government
